



## Salt Lake City Bicycle Collective Bicycle Mechanic Position

The Salt Lake City Bicycle Collective (SLCBC) has openings for one or more bicycle mechanics. These are part- or full-time positions, depending on the applicant's needs and preferences. These are not seasonal positions; mechanics at the SLCBC have the opportunity to work a regular schedule year round.

Mechanics at the SLCBC are responsible for refurbishing bikes to be sold in the shop, as well as bikes to be donated through our charitable programs. They will also work one or more shifts per week of open shop (DIY and sales), during which they will assist customers who are working on their own bikes or who wish to make purchases. The ideal candidate will have a broad understanding of bicycle repair, and will be able and willing to work on a wide variety of bikes (80's road bikes, 90's mountain bikes, new high-end bikes, department store bikes, etc.). They will also possess a strong work ethic, attention to detail, and be highly motivated to help the SLCBC achieve its mission.

### Preferred qualifications:

- Minimum of 1 season (6 months) paid shop experience
- Experience handling cash and running a point-of-sale system, preferably Square
- Working knowledge of all aspects of bicycle repair, and willingness to work on a wide variety of bikes
- Proficiency with a wide range of bicycle technology and tools (1960's-present)
- Ability to work on a deadline and within financial constraints
- Strong work ethic, attention to detail, and integrity
- Must be willing to work some evenings and Saturdays

### Responsibilities:

- Repair bikes to be sold or to be donated through our charitable programs, tracking time and parts used per project
- Maintain a clean, organized, and safe workspace
- Assist with other tasks as needed such as organizing bikes and parts, keeping a list of needed supplies, etc.
- Assist customers who are performing repairs on their own bikes, or shopping for bikes, parts, or accessories
- Maintain a high level of professionalism and provide excellent customer service
- Occasionally help with the SLCBC's other programs as needed
